EQUINE EMERGENCY FIRST AID KIT

1. **Digital Thermometer**
2. **Stethoscope**
3. **4 Quilt Leg Wraps**
4. **4 Standing Wraps**
5. **4 Rolls of 4" Vetrap by 3M**
6. **1 Roll Cotton**
7. **1 Package of 3" by 3" or larger Gauze Pads**
8. **1 Package of 3" or larger Non-Adhesive Gauze Pads**
9. **Antibiotic Ointment (Nolvasan, Nitrofurazone or Neosporin)**
10. **Sterile Saline Wash (for eyes)**
11. **Sterile Saline Spray**
12. **One of the following Anti-Bacterial solutions: Betadine, Povidone or Chlorhexidine**
13. **Duct Tape**
14. **Diapers for Hoof wrap**
15. **White Bandage Tape – 1" wide**
16. **Tool to pull shoes**
17. **Prescription Medications specific to your Equine's needs and/or history (i.e. Phenylbutazone Tablets or Paste, Banamine Paste, Penicillin or Sulfa Tablets etc.)**
18. **Your Veterinarians Phone Number**

It is recommended that you keep all these items in a durable plastic box (preferably weatherproof) labeled Equine First Aid Kit. Keep this Kit in an easily accessible location and always take it with you when transporting your horse.

Having these items handy will allow you and your veterinarian to provide quality emergency care until help arrives.
